Steering Committee – Community Member

The Toronto HIV/AIDS Network (THN) is seeking a community member who is living with HIV to become a member of its Steering Committee. This volunteer position provides an opportunity to contribute to the leadership team of the THN which facilitates HIV/AIDS planning, collaboration, engagement and innovation to improve access to programs and services for people from diverse communities living with and most affected by HIV/AIDS.

The Toronto HIV/AIDS Network (THN) includes AIDS Service Organizations (ASOs), HIV-related programs, people living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs), community members, and broader organizations that have an impact upon the lives of people living with and at risk of HIV/AIDS. As a network, THN does not deliver direct services to individuals.

Steering Committee Community Member qualifications:

- Lived experience as a PHA who is currently or has in the past accessed services and who is a resident of the City of Toronto.
- Knowledge of HIV community and services.
- Ability to contribute as an independent voice with a broad community perspective, regardless of any affiliation or connection with an ASO or HIV specific program.
- Experience in governance leadership roles through (e.g. Advisory Committee or Board).
- Experience with and sensitivity to diverse communities.
- Demonstrated development in leadership, for example, Ontario AIDS Network (OAN) PHA Leadership Development Training or other PHA capacity-building program, and/or committee experience.

Time and participation commitment:

- Steering Committee meetings (generally 2-3 hours each and a minimum of 4 times a year with occasionally additional meetings for project focused work)
- THN Members' meetings twice a year
- Appointment is for 3 years. Minimum of one year commitment is essential.

An honorarium is available to the Community members on the Steering Committee to recognize and support this level of volunteer lived experience contribution.
