### The needs of PHAs and service providers

- In 2005-2006, the Toronto HIV/AIDS Community Planning Initiative (TCPI) conducted consultations with people living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs) and service providers.
- Responses revealed that lack of up-to-date information about services hampered accessibility and the ability of service providers to make referrals.

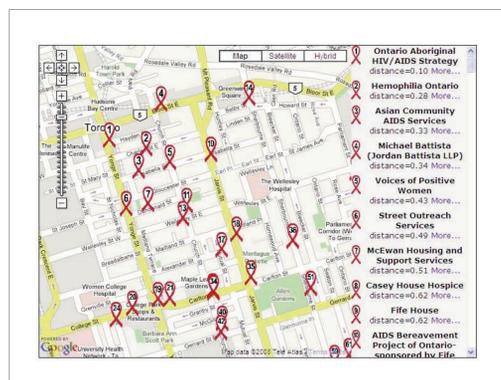
### Developing an accessible, coordinated HIV/AIDS service information system

- TCPI requested the Information and Access Working Group to develop an accessible, Internet-based tool to provide information on HIV/AIDS-related services in Toronto.
- The working group reviewed various existing information tools before partnering with the Ontario HIV Treatment Network (OHTN) to expand the scope of their “ASO411” project and fulfill TCPI’s recommendations.
- The project partners developed the online search tool – ASO411 – which is available online at [www.aso411.ca](http://www.aso411.ca). ASO411 is an interactive mapping system that provides access to up-to-date information on HIV/AIDS-related services in Ontario.
- The working group will continue to update and maintain ASO411, increase the involvement of PHAs, and promote the tool to various communities of users.
