### Who We Are:

CSSP is a non-profit, multi-service organization serving the Latinx/Hispanic community for close to 50 years in the GTA. CSSP is a well-established organization respected by its clients, partners, and funders. We provide a wide variety of services and outreach to our community members. As a leader in the community, we plan to grow the impact and reach of our programs: Settlement, Legal Clinic, VAW, HIV/AIDS Prevention, Youth and Seniors.

CSSP is seeking applicants for a full-time HIV/AIDS Outreach Worker position. This is an ongoing position, contingent on funding, which will be open as of May 18, 2022. The outreach worker will be part of our HIV/AIDS Prevention Program and will engage in activities including client intakes, assessment, and intervention plans, as well as community outreach and public education. The successful candidate will have a high degree of professionalism, a collaborative approach to their work, strong interpersonal skills, a dynamic work ethic and the ability to effectively develop solutions as a critical thinker.

### What You Will Do:

- Responsible for program development and outreach to the Latinx/Hispanic LGBTQ+ community
- Engage actively in community events to assist clients with their needs and promote CSSP programs
- Inform manager of service delivery issues and matters of interest and concerns
- Connect clients with emergency support and services, including health/medical care, housing, legal, education, employment, income supplements, referrals to partners and agencies
- Facilitate the planning, coordination, and execution of workshops, support groups and information sessions
- Promote and organize events, webinars, videos, develop and collaborate with distributions of printed information resources for Latinx/Hispanic LGTBQ+ community
- Organize and support volunteer recruitment for the program delivery
- Participate in community projects, collaborate to increase number of clients
- Support management and program counsellors to facilitate implementation of activities and tasks according to established workplan and timeline
- Prepare and deliver weekly activity reports and timesheets
- Maintain accurate and current client records
- Assist in the preparation of program reports as required
- Provide intake and registration of clients receiving services following established protocols
- Participate in staff, network committee and Board meetings as required

- Other duties as required to ensure the continuation of service to the community
